

# Prairie Meadows 2009 Community Betterment Grant Program Resolution for School Districts, Cities and Counties

Prairie Meadows requires all Community Betterment Grant Applications for organizations or departments that represent a school district, city or a county be approved and ranked in order of need by their school board, city council or county board of supervisors.

Community Betterment Grant Applications received by Prairie Meadows without the appropriate resolution from the school district, city or county will not be considered for funding.

## **SCHOOL DISTRICTS**

Any and all organizations that operate for the betterment of a school or school district must have prior approval from their respective school board. This includes all schools, classrooms and departments within the district as well.

All Community Betterment Grant Applications must be submitted to the school board for approval. The school board will compile all Community Betterment Grant Applications and submit a completed resolution stating they approve the submission of the grant applications and are ranked in order of need as determined by the school board at its discretion.

The school board must submit the completed resolution and Community Betterment Grant Applications to Prairie Meadows by August 15, 2009.

## **CITIES**

Any and all organizations that operate for the betterment of a city must have prior approval from their respective city council. This includes all city departments, recreation and betterment groups within the city limits.

All Community Betterment Grant Applications must be submitted to the city council for approval. The city council will compile all Community Betterment Grant Applications and submit a completed resolution stating they approve the submission of the grant applications and are ranked in order of need as determined by the council at its discretion.

The city council must submit the completed resolution and Community Betterment Grant Applications to Prairie Meadows by August 15, 2009.

## **COUNTIES**

Any and all organizations that operate for the betterment of a county must have prior approval from their respective county boards of supervisors. This includes all county departments, recreation and betterment groups within the entire county.

All Community Betterment Grant Applications must be submitted to the county board of supervisors for approval. The county board of supervisors will compile all Community Betterment Grant Applications and submit a completed resolution stating they approve the submission of the grant applications and are ranked in order of need as determined by the county board of supervisors at its discretion.

The county board of supervisors must submit the completed resolution and Community Betterment Grant Applications to Prairie Meadows by August 15, 2009.
